## NARRATIVE

\*BWV & ICV RECORDED

On 02/09/2025 at about 1153hrs, while on uniformed duty with officer N. LEMBERG as 2L22, we responded to the report of an assault at the Kraken Community Iceplex located at 10651 5 AV NE. The caller was listed as FINE, DANIELLE, hereafter referred to as FINE. The call read as follows:

**VIRGINIA ICE RINK. J/O. CALLER REPORTING A 16 YOA REF WAS PUSHED BY AN IRATE PRAENT. MEDICS DECLINED. UNK WHERE SUSP IS CURRENTLY. NO WPNS SEEN.**

The suspect was described as follows:

**WM, 40'S, 6'0, HEAVY, GRY BEANIE, BLK NORTHFACE PUFFER JKT, BLK PANTS, BRO SHOES.**

Prior to our arrival, FINE updated that the suspect was leaving the scene in an SUV, WA LIC/ AWE5570 towards the west side of the complex. The license plate returned to a silver 2015 GMC Yukon registered to AUSRA CORTES.

We arrived at about 1200hrs and located the suspect vehicle stopped for traffic at a red light at NE 107 ST and 1 AV NE. Officer LEMBERG and I initiated the stop with our emergency lights. The driver matched the suspect description and officer LEMBERG asked him to step out of the vehicle.

Officer LEMBERG informed the suspect of the reason for police contact and read him his Miranda rights. The suspect said he understood his rights. Officer LEMBERG asked the suspect if he spoke English or needed a to be spoken to in Spanish. The suspect said he spoke and understood English fluently. I later identified the suspect via WA driver's license as CORTES GONZALEZ, URIEL, hereafter referred to as URIEL.

URIEL did not appear injured or impaired by any drugs or alcohol. I asked URIEL for his account of what occurred; URIEL reported the following:

URIEL was at his son's hockey game and saw his son assaulted by a player from the opposing team. URIEL said his son was punched and kicked for about thirty seconds and the referees did nothing to stop the assault. URIEL said he went onto the ice to defend his son and to break up the fight. URIEL said he pushed a referee to get to his son and told the do something about the fights. URIEL said another adult also got on the ice and yelled at him to get off the ice. URIEL said he removed his son and left. URIEL said he acted in defense of his son.

URIEL identified his son as C [REDACTED], A [REDACTED]. URIEL said his son and wife (AUSRA CORTES) were inside the SUV.

I checked URIEL for warrants; he checked clear.

Meanwhile officer LEMBERG contacted A [REDACTED] his AUSRA, which yielded the following:

A [REDACTED] reported no injuries from the fight with the opposing hockey player. A [REDACTED] did see his father on the ice after his fight.

AUSRA corroborated URIEL's account of a fight between the players which included their son A [REDACTED]. AUSRA saw her husband go onto the ice during the stop of the game. AUSRA did not see URIEL assault anyone. AUSRA said the game was not over when they left. AUSRA said URIEL rushed her and A [REDACTED] out from the game when she saw him "go crazy."

FINE and several other witnesses offered video of the incident that was collected from the surveillance from the complex.

The video footage was captured from a wide vantage point behind the box of officials. The video showed a man who matched URIEL's physical description walk onto the ice from the left side of the officials box towards a referee who spoke to officials in the box. There was no fight at the time and the game was stopped. URIEL walked directly towards one referee and shoved him with enough force to knock him onto his back. The victim appeared to be caught off guard and was the assault appeared to be unprovoked.

At this point, there was probable cause for misdemeanor assault. I informed URIEL that probable cause existed for assault due to the video footage and that the victim was a juvenile. URIEL said he was not aware that the referee was a juvenile and said he would participate as needed for the investigation. Additionally, URIEL said he takes responsibility for his actions. I gathered URIEL's contact information and advised him that I would recommend charges for assault to the court. I gave URIEL a business card and case number and released him from the scene.

Officer LEMBERG and I spoke to multiple witnesses. I spoke to a witness who identified herself as BOSWELL, KRISTIN, hereafter referred to as BOSWELL who reported the following:

BOSWELL said she was seated at the box of officials operating music for the game. BOSWELL saw URIEL walk onto the ice during the break in the game and noticed URIEL's gaze at her as he walked towards the referees. BOSWELL saw URIEL shove one referee from behind and then another. URIEL knocked both referees to the ground. BOSWELL did not remember hearing what URIEL said before, during or after the assault. BOSWELL saw other adults go onto the ice and lost track of URIEL in the chaos.

Meanwhile, Officer LEMBERG spoke to another witness; see officer LEMBERG's statement for details.

I went inside to interview the two juvenile victims who were identified as S [REDACTED], H [REDACTED] & S [REDACTED], L [REDACTED]. I called for SFD medics to treat S [REDACTED] & [REDACTED]. S [REDACTED] complained of pain to his rear right hip; S [REDACTED] complained of pain to his right elbow. SFD engine 39 responded to treat the injuries of each victim.

Meanwhile officer LEMBERG gathered video surveillance of the assault and sent Axon links for the submission of the evidence.

After SFD medics treated both victims for their injuries, I then interviewed S [REDACTED] and S [REDACTED] with their respective parent present. S [REDACTED]'S mother identified herself as HUANG, IRENE. S [REDACTED]'s mother identified herself as SECAN, CLAUDIA.

I interviewed S [REDACTED] first which yielded the following:

S [REDACTED] did not have any obvious injuries. S [REDACTED] wore protective gear at the time of the assault which included a helmet, elbow pads, and shin guards. S [REDACTED] complained of pain to his rear right hip and rear neck which he said felt stiff. I checked the condition of S [REDACTED]'s helmet and saw no obvious damage to the exterior shell or the interior foam.

S [REDACTED] said he was a referee at the time of the incident when a fight broke out between two players. S [REDACTED] and his fellow referee broke up the fight that lasted all of 10 seconds. S [REDACTED] and his fellow referee stopped the game to separate the players who fought and then documented the fight with the officials in the box. As he spoke to officials, he heard someone shout "Get the fuck off my kid!" S [REDACTED] then felt a strong push that knocked him off his skates and he fell on the ice on his back. S [REDACTED] said his head hit the ice, but he did not lose consciousness nor did he feel dizzy immediately afterwards.

S [REDACTED] saw the adult shove the other referee to the ground also, but did not see where the suspect went to afterwards since there was a flurry of adults and shouting that followed.

S [REDACTED] said he would recognize the suspect if he saw him again. S [REDACTED] described the suspect as a white male, tall, heavy build, light skin, who wore a beanie a hoodie and had stubble. S [REDACTED] said the suspect was a stranger to him who he had no previous contact with before.

I then interviewed S [REDACTED] who reported the following:

S [REDACTED] did not have any obvious injuries. S [REDACTED] wore protective gear at the time of the assault which included a helmet and a neck guard. S [REDACTED] complained of pain to his right elbow. I checked the condition of S [REDACTED]'s helmet and saw no obvious damage to the exterior shell or the interior foam.

S [REDACTED] was a referee for a hockey game at the time of the incident. A fight broke out that S [REDACTED] and S [REDACTED] broke up. S [REDACTED] and S [REDACTED] stopped the game to separate the players who fought and to confer with officials to determine any penalties from the fight. They were interrupted when S [REDACTED] heard a man shout "Get the fuck off my kid!" S [REDACTED] remembered he was pushed first into the wall and was knocked down when he landed on his right elbow. Then more adults shouted and got on the ice in response. S [REDACTED] said he almost cried due to the overwhelming situation.

I gathered the contact information for each juvenile and their parents. Both victims agreed to participate in prosecution. I advised both victims to go the doctor if their injuries worsened and to sign a medical release form to include the medical records as evidence for this case. I later emailed both parents a copy of the medical release form. I gave both parents a business card and case number.

URIEL's DOL physicals list him as 6'02 inches, 245lbs. Both of the victims are likely not the equal in weight or size cumulatively. Both victims are not even 15 years old and URIEL is over 40 years old. There is no evidence that supports URIEL's claim that he acted in defense of his son at the time of the assault. Multiple direct witnesses and video surveillance corroborated the account of the victims. URIEL's assault on two juveniles was clearly unprovoked and the conduct was especially egregious due to the size and age difference between the victims and the suspect.

URIEL has ties to the community which includes a fixed home address, a wife and a child. URIEL said he would take responsibility for his actions and would participate with the investigation on scene. Based on URIEL's ties to the community and his level of cooperation on scene, I believe he will respond to the court should charges be brought forward by the prosecutor.

Probable cause exists for two counts of misdemeanor assault.

I recommend this completed misdemeanor investigation of CORTES GONZALEZ, URIEL ISAAC be referred to the Seattle Law Department for the crime of assault 4 RCW 9A.36.041.

**NARRATIVE**

.On 2/9/25, at approximately 1150 hours, I was dispatched to a report of an assault at the Kraken Community Iceplex at 10601 5 Ave NE. The call stated, "VIRGINIA ICE RINK. J/O. CALLER REPORTING A 16 YOA REF WAS PUSHED BY AN IRATE PRAENT. MEDICS DECLINED. UNK WHERE SUSP IS CURRENTLY. NO WPNS SEEN." The suspect was described as: WM, 40'S, 6'0, HEAVY, GRY BEANIE, BLK NORTHFACE PUFFER JKT, BLK PANTS, BRO SHOES.

The caller, W/Fine, provided additional updates of the suspect location. The suspect eventually left the facility and entered a vehicle with plate, WA/AWE5570, a GMC Yukon.

I arrived in the area, with my partner Officer Lopez, as the described vehicle was leaving the area. I observed a similar vehicle near NE 103 St/1 Ave NE. I confirmed the Yukon had the same listed plate attached.

I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and contacted the driver. I had the driver step out of the vehicle and walk to our patrol car. I advised the driver, identified as S/Cortes Gonzalez, that he was being recorded. Officer Lopez advised S/Cortes Gonzalez was the only adult male in the vehicle.

As there was reasonable suspicion to detain S/Cortes Gonzalez and I wished to ask him questions about the incident, I read him Miranda rights from my SPD MIR card. S/Cortes Gonzalez stated, "Yes" when asked if he understood his rights. Noting an accent, I asked the language he felt most comfortable speaking and he replied English.

Officer Lopez primarily interviewed S/Cortes Gonzalez but I did stand by for parts of the interview. S/Cortes Gonzalez initially indicated there was nothing involving a fight at the ice hockey complex which he wished to speak about.

I was flagged over by W/Fine at that time. W/Fine, who identified herself as "SPD", confirmed the male detained by police was the correct suspect. She reported the suspect "violently" shoved two juvenile referees across the ice and that one of the victims had a back injury as a result.

I walked by to Officer Lopez and S/Cortes Gonzalez and heard S/Cortes Gonzalez state, "I shoved the referees" and described several people around as he went to grab his child. He stated the referees were "not doing anything" and he told them they have to "take control of this game". He reported his child got "punched".

I took photos of S/Cortes Gonzalez and uploaded the photos to evidence.com

I spoke to both W/Ausra and W/A[REDACTED] in the GMC Yukon. W/Ausra is the wife of S/Cortes Gonzalez and W/A[REDACTED] is their son.

W/Ausra stated she was mostly watching the game but did look up and see her husband was walking out on the ice. This was due to a fight on the ice involving W/A[REDACTED] and "the referees not saying anything" and "somebody's going to get hurt". W/Ausra then began to walk around the rink and did not see her husband engage in any physical encounter. W/Ausra later admitted they left before the game was over because her husband "went crazy". She also stated it was "not really" normal for parents to walk out on the ice during a game.

W/A[REDACTED] stated he was involved in a fight during the game. Another player hit him with a stick, kicked and punched him. He stated he was not injured. He stated he "didn't see the whole part" because he was leaving to change. He also stated it is "not normal" for a parent to come onto the ice during a game.

W/Fine flagged me down again and showed me surveillance video of the assault. In the video, a male is clearly seen coming onto the ice, approaching and then pushing a referee. The referee falls to the ice and was not engaged with the suspect prior to the assault.

I showed this video to Officer Lopez, who then confronted S/Cortes Gonzalez. The video apparently contradicted statements S/Cortes Gonzalez made about protecting his son. S/Cortes Gonzalez, when confronted about the contradiction, stated "I take responsibility".
