DECLARATION OF FRED MARSHALL

I, Fred Marshall, state and declare as follows:

1. I am a Registered and Licensed Process Server for Seattle Legal Messengers. I am over eighteen years old, and I am not a party to or interest in the above-entitled action. I make this Declaration based on my personal knowledge and belief.
2. On May 9, 2024, I attempted to serve Miles Oliver Hudson. I went to the West Edge Apartments at 1430 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue in Seattle, and management allowed me to enter the building and go to apartment 3407.
3. I went to apartment 3407 and knocked on the door. I identified myself as having a delivery for Miles. A male voice on the other side of the door said, "I didn't order anything." I repeated that

1 I had a delivery for him, and he said, "I don't want it." The voice was high-pitched and distinctive.

2 I surmised that he Miles Hudson because of his "I" answers. I did not hear other voices in the  
3 unit. He did not open the door.

4 4. I returned on May 10, 2024, to the same building and apartment. I was let into the building by  
5 the management and went to apartment 3407. This time, I spoke to a person behind the door with  
6 the same distinctive voice. He opened the door a small amount and leaned around the door to  
7 accept the Summons and Complaint, which I handed to him.

8 5. I did not see his entire body; however, I saw his face. He is a Black male who appeared to be  
9 5'9" tall. His hair was covered with what appeared to be a do-rag. It is my practice to enter the  
10 weight as provided to me by the customer if I cannot precisely determine the servee's weight.

11 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing  
12 is true and correct, and that this declaration was executed this 24<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2024, at Seattle,  
13 Washington.
