2 2.1 **Appearances.** The City appeared by Cindi Williams, Assistant City Attorney.

6 **III. AFFIDAVIT OF CERTAINTY**

7 3.1 **Amount Certain.** The amount sought by the City is certain.

8 **IV. ORDER & JUDGMENT**

9 THIS MATTER having come before the Court on the City's motion for default judgment
10 against Defendant; and the Court having considered the pleadings, declarations, records, and files
11 herein and being duly advised in the premises; NOW, THEREFORE,

12 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

13 4.1 **Default.** The City is entitled to default judgment herein and to all relief it has requested.
14 The Defendant was declared to be in default and this Court entered an Order for Default on June 18,
15 2024.

16 4.2 **Money Judgment.** The City is awarded judgment for civil penalties (\$83,200.00). Civil
17 penalties are awarded under Seattle Municipal Code 25.08.800.A.

18 4.3 **Order to comply.** The Court orders the Defendant to comply with Seattle Department
19 of Construction and Inspections Notice of Violation 1057987-VI and SMC Title 25 by restoring the
20 Charger vehicle to a condition that complies with the requirements of the Seattle Municipal Code and
21 pass an inspection by the Seattle Police Department (Lt. Randy Ward can be contacted to coordinate
22 that inspection);

23 4.4 **Costs (Service).** The City is awarded its costs in the amount of \$219.97.

1 4.5 **Costs (Statutory Attorneys' Fees)**. The City is awarded its statutory attorneys' fees in
2 the amount of **\$200.00**;

3 4.6 **Interest**. The City is awarded interest on the judgment at the rate of 12% per annum;

4 4.7 **Continuing Jurisdiction**. This Court retains jurisdiction over this matter for purposes of
5 ensuring that the Charger vehicle passes inspection as described above in paragraph 4.3;

6 4.8 **No Bond**. The City is exempt from providing security pursuant to RCW 4.96.050; and

7 4.9 The City is awarded any other and further legal or equitable relief as the Court deems
8 just and proper.
