INSTRUCTIONS FOR SURRENDERING FIREARM(S):

You have been ordered to surrender firearms to the Seattle Police Department. Please read and follow the instructions on this form.

1. Firearms can only be accepted by the Evidence Unit located at 730 South Stacy Street, Building "C," Seattle, WA 98134 between 8:00 am - 4:00 pm, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday *excluding holidays*. Go up the ramp, push the door button, then tell evidence personnel that you are surrendering firearms per a court order.
2. **ALL FIREARMS MUST BE UNLOADED AND RENDERED SAFE TO HANDLE.** Do not bring firearms inside the building until directed to do so. **Loaded firearms will not be accepted under any circumstance.**
3. Bring a copy of your court order.
4. You will be given a detailed receipt, listing all items surrendered. You should keep the receipt and this document in a safe place for later reference.
