) **CITY'S SENTENCING MEMORANDUM**

15 **I. INTRODUCTION**

16 COMES NOW the City of Seattle, by and through City Attorney, ANN DAVISON,  
17 represented herein by Senior Assistant City Prosecutor, Christopher T. Karr, with the following  
18 sentencing memorandum.  
19

20 Mr. Hudon was convicted of one count of Reckless Driving and one count of Reckless  
21 Driving – Racing by unanimous jury verdict on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The sentencing hearing for the case  
22 was set over to July 7, 2025.

23 **II. SENTENCING RECOMMENDATION**  
24

25 The City is making the following recommendations in case 4240000362.

26 The City is recommending on 1) Count 1, Reckless Driving: 364/330 (credit time serve  
27 of 4 days), \$5000/\$5000, No criminal law violations, No driving without a valid drivers license,  
28

1 No driving without insurance, 24 months jurisdiction, Driver's license suspension per  
2 Department of Licensing, No using social media to advance, create, perpetuate or show illegal  
3 behavior, No using social media to post or comment on past or present legal proceedings to  
4 which Mr. Hudson is a party, No vehicle noise complaint violations, No speeding infractions  
5 where the cited speed is more than ten (10) miles over the posted speed limit, No street racing,  
6 No driving vehicle known as the Belltown Hellcat (vehicle with VIN #2C3CDXL97PH503197)  
7 within the city limits of the City of Seattle, Defensive Driving School Level 2, 40 Community  
8 Service Hours;

11 2) Count 2, Reckless Driving-Racing: 364/330 (credit time served of 4 days),  
12 \$5000/\$5000, No criminal law violations, No driving without a valid drivers license, No  
13 driving without insurance, 24 months jurisdiction, Driver's license suspension per Department  
14 of Licensing, No using social media to advance, create, perpetuate or show illegal behavior, No  
15 using social media to post or comment on past or present legal proceedings to which Mr.  
16 Hudson is a party, No vehicle noise complaint violations, No speeding infractions where the  
17 cited speed is more than ten (10) miles over the posted speed limit, No street racing, No driving  
18 vehicle known as the Belltown Hellcat (vehicle with VIN #2C3CDXL97PH503197) within the  
19 city limits of the City of Seattle, Defensive Driving School Level 2, 40 Community Service  
20 Hour;  
21

23 Counts 1 and 2 to run consecutive with each other.

### 24 **III. FACTS OF THE CASE**

25 The defendant committed the crime of Reckless Driving and Reckless Driving-Racing.  
26 Between December of 2023 and February of 2024, Mr. Hudson filmed himself approaching a  
27

1 group of individuals on 2<sup>nd</sup> avenue in Downtown Seattle. Mr. Hudson challenged these  
2 individuals to a race and proceeded to race said individuals down Fourth Avenue in the City of  
3 Seattle. He filmed this race on his cell phone and posted that video to his Instagram account. At  
4 times the visible speedometer on his vehicle read as high as 107 miles per hour (“mph”). Mr.  
5 Hudson admitted in testimony that he was driving the vehicle and filming the entire incident.  
6 The video clearly shows that Mr. Hudson, while travelling over 100 mph, had only one hand on  
7 the wheel and used to other hand to hold the camera, at times panning the camera to look  
8 behind him to the vehicle struggling to keep up with his extreme speed.

#### 11 **IV. CRIMINAL HISTORY**

12 Outside of these convictions, Mr. Hudsons criminal history includes convictions for:  
13 Disclosing Intimate Images without Consent (SMC #4240002153 – DOV 5/9/24); Assault 4 -  
14 DV (Renton Municipal #2A0321378 – DOV 4/27/22); and Malicious Mischief 3 – DV (Renton  
15 Municipal #1A0126815 – DOV 12/2/21). He also has the following infractions found  
16 committed: No Drivers License on Person (SMC #5240043126 – 4/1/24); Unlawful  
17 Muffler/Exhaust, No Drivers License on Person, Vehicle Sounds exceeds 75 feet (SMC  
18 #55240041294 – 3/30/24); Speed 11-15 MPH Limit 40&Under Zone, Unlawful  
19 Muffler/Exhaust, License Plate not Attached (SMC #5240089019 – 3/20/24); Improper  
20 Lamp/Reflector Color (SMC #5240021391 – 3/20/24); Unlawful Muffler/Exhaust (MSC  
21 #5240000005 – 2/29/24); Prohibited Lighting Equipment (Kirkland Municipal #4A0225291 –  
22 2/6/24); Speeding (Skagit County District #3A0657672 – 9/17/23).

#### 25 **V. BASIS FOR THE CITY’S RECOMMENDATION**

1 The City has put forth this sentencing recommendation due to the history of bad driving,  
2 community complaints, own admissions while testifying, continued disregard for the Courts  
3 orders and his behavior in the video he filed and posted online showing him street racing  
4 through Seattle at over 100 mph. At every opportunity, Mr. Hudson has flaunted the courts  
5 order and the law. He has continually violated his conditions of release, whether it be continued  
6 posting on social media, absconding from his EHM requirements for hours at a time without  
7 permission or filming court proceedings without express permission (and posting that footage  
8 on social media). Mr. Hudson filmed himself driving at 107 mph through the streets of  
9 downtown Seattle, while holding the steering wheel with one hand and filming the incident  
10 with the other. This incredibly risky and dangerous behavior was done in an effort to become a  
11 social media influencer, that is gain both attention and profit. He showed little to no remorse or  
12 understanding of the dangerous nature of his actions in his testimony, professing that he has a  
13 duty to create content and keep his “fandom” engaged.

14  
15  
16  
17 Mr. Hudson put on a defense at his trial, testifying that the video was heavily edited to  
18 only appear to be travelling at extreme speeds. He testified that he hired a video editor who  
19 works on his videos. Under his own counsels questioning, he testified that you can alter a  
20 speedometer in a video by fading the visual numbers, applying a mask over it and then  
21 inserting digital numbers at whatever value is desired. What he did not testify to was whether  
22 that process was done on the video he created of him racing through downtown Seattle. The  
23 jury heard his testimony and the evidence presented by the City, weighed that evidence,  
24 assessed its credibility and then distinctly, directly and unanimously rejected Mr. Hudsons

1 explanation of his behavior in favor of the evidence they saw with their own eyes: the video of  
2 Mr. Hudson challenging a group to a street race and then driving on City streets at 107 mph.

3 Mr. Hudson has an unfortunate history of police contact, though he generally presents as a  
4 pleasant and amiable young kid. He has mostly been contacted for noise complaints regarding  
5 his vehicle. However, his actions in this case have put anyone on the road with him in danger.  
6 He does not seem to understand or particularly care about the effect his pursuit of fame has on  
7 the community. This is evidenced by the fact that Mr. Hudson attempted to and inquired about  
8 live streaming his own trial for his fans. This appears to all be a show for Mr. Hudson, where  
9 every moment and every hearing is an opportunity to gain more fame, or perhaps infamy. The  
10 recommendation proposed by the City is aimed at curbing that mindset and behavior.

### 13 VI. CONCLUSION

14 In light of the defendant's history and the facts and evidence admitted in this case, the  
15 City moves this court to adopt the sentencing recommendation noted above and impose it.  
16
