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INSTRUCTIONS TO DEFENDANT

You have been charged with a violation of the Seattle Municipal Code or Revised Code of Washington. The charge involved a criminal offense. A conviction can result in a fine or in jail time (up to \$5,000 and/or 364 days for a gross misdemeanor). The alleged offense(s) requires that you appear in court to answer the charge(s).

You are hereby ordered to appear in court at the location, date and time stated above. Failure to appear at the time and place specified may result in a warrant for your arrest, the suspension of your driving privileges or other sanctions allowed by law.

To appear for your court hearing by video/telephone, go to the Court's website:

www.seattle.gov/courts/virtual-hearings.

You are presumed innocent until you are either convicted or plead guilty to the charge(s). You have a right to a jury trial.

Right to an Attorney: You have a right to have an attorney for this and all other hearings. If you cannot afford to hire your own attorney, you may be eligible for a public defender. However, in accordance with RCW 10.101.020, you must be interviewed to determine whether you qualify financially for a public defender. It may be found that you are eligible for an attorney provided at no cost to you or that you are required to financially offset the cost of the defense. It may also be found that you are financially ineligible for a public defender. To assist the court in making this determination, please bring your recent income tax returns, recent paycheck stubs, or proof of public assistance, poverty-related veteran's benefits, food stamps or unemployment compensation. **Failure to properly document your claim of indigency may require you to contribute to the cost of a public defender.**

Do not assume that you automatically qualify for, or already have, a public defender. If you wish to screen for or retain an appointed attorney, please call (206) 386-1543 or promptly go to the Municipal Court of Seattle, 600 Fifth Avenue, Seattle, WA. Defense screening services are located on the 8th Floor – check in at the Probation office windows. The office is open Monday to Friday, except holidays, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m..

It is important that you retain an attorney immediately. This will allow the attorney sufficient time to prepare your case and may result in fewer court appearances for you.
