- D. A dismissal is entered.

Each attorney, plaintiff/petitioner, or a representative designated in writing may withdraw the exhibits s/he has provided to the Clerk.

2. Exhibits not withdrawn within 90 days following case completion as defined above will be destroyed without further order of the Court.
