You have been charged with a violation of the Seattle Municipal Code and/or the Revised Code of Washington. The charge involved is a criminal offense. A conviction can result in a fine or in jail time (up to \$5,000 and/or 364 days for a gross misdemeanor). The alleged offense(s) requires that you appear in court to answer to the charge(s).

You are hereby ordered to appear at the time and place specified in the enclosed summons. Failure to appear at the time and place specified may result in a warrant for your arrest, the suspension of your driving privileges or other sanctions allowed by law.

You are presumed innocent until you are either convicted or plead guilty to the charge(s). You have a right to a jury trial.

Right to Attorney: You have a right to be represented by an attorney at this and all other hearings. At the hearing specified on the summons on the reverse side, you will be able to discuss your case with a public defender to determine how you wish to respond to the alleged offense(s). If you plead not guilty and cannot afford to hire your own attorney, you may be eligible for a public defender to represent you at subsequent hearings. However, in accordance with RCW 10.101.020, you must be interviewed to determine whether you qualify financially for a public defender. It may be found that you are eligible for an attorney provided at no cost or that you are required to financially offset the cost of the defense. It may also be found that you are financially ineligible for a public defender. To assist the court in making this determination, please bring your recent income tax returns, recent paycheck stubs, or proof of public assistance, poverty-related veteran's benefits, food stamps or unemployment compensation.

Failure to properly document your claim of indigency may require you to contribute to the cost of a public defender.

Do not assume that you automatically qualify for, or already have, a public defender. You must be interviewed to determine eligibility and/or ability to pay. A financial screener will be present at the hearing, and you can be interviewed at that time. If you wish to screen for a public defender before your hearing, please call (206) 386-1543.
